INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

INTRODUCTION

The accessory condenser hail guard doors are designed to protect the coils of the Argus line of Condensing units from harsh weather conditions and debris. See **TABLE 1** for accessory package usage, and see **TABLE 2** for accessory package contents. One accessory kit is required for each unit.

Check each item for shipping damage. If any damage is found, file a claim with the shipping agent immediately. If any item is missing or if any part does not assemble properly, notify your Tecumseh representative.

To avoid the possibility of electrical shock, open and tag all disconnects before installing this equipment. Be aware that there may be more than one disconnect.







MOUNTING INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Make sure the unit is switched off. Lockout and disconnect all the power connections.
- Remove the hail guard unit from the carton and position against the unit, as shown in Figure 1 & 2.
- 3. Mark the top screw mounting locations from the Hail guard assembly, as shown in Figure 3.
- 4. Drill pilot holes (0.2" or less) at the marked locations. Make sure the internal components are untouched. Pilot holes are optional as the unit comes with self-tapping sheet metal screws.
- 5. Mount the Hail guard on to the unit using the provided self-tapping screws Figure 4.
- 6. Make sure the unit is secure before turning on the power supply.









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
